8.1 FYI Report: Operational Points of Interest to the Board

Adopt-A-Highway - From Sacramento Street to Idaho Maryland on highway 49, there will be a BriarPatch-sponsored Adopt a Highway section of the highway where the Co-op will pay for that area to be cleaned, planted, and maintained. Freeway signs will showcase BriarPatch's new logo.

2017 Sales were an amazing \$32,713.276, which was a 6.4% growth, significantly higher than budgeted growth of 4%.

Alan noted that he has received comments from three or four people regarding how nice it was that BriarPatch donated snacks and fruit to SYRCL for the Wild and Scenic Film Festival.

Kali noted that it was fantastic to see such a large Nevada County presence at Eco-farm this year, and all of the support that BriarPatch provides to local farmers.

8.2 B-9 Emergency GM Succession Monitoring Report: This monitoring report is focused on the Board's B-9 policy that states that the GM shall not fail to provide a succession plan that designates not less than one other manager sufficiently familiar with Board and GM issues and processes to enable her/him to take over with reasonable proficiency as an interim GM.

9.0 Development Planning (Open Session):

9.1 Development Progress Update: Andrea provided the Board with a schematic of the proposed work for the refrigeration, ADA access and delivery yard remodel project. We are currently in the design process. Once the drawings are finalized, there will be a cost estimate and Andrea will do her proforma work to determine the financial impact on the Coop. This will happen in February. The next step is to go out to bid, select the general contractor and refine the costs a second time. The general contractor will then select the sub-contractors, get permits together, and then a better cost will be provided prior to start of construction. This should be a short project, with actual construction spanning 1-2 months.
